

BCI CHURCHES

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

We have worked hard to ensure that anyone attending a service at St Hubert's Idsworth will be as safe as possible.

If you are in the clinically extremely vulnerable group, you are advised that there is a risk attending an indoor church service, however careful we are.

If you have any Covid-19 symptoms, (cough, temperature, loss of taste or smell) please do not attend a church service.

If you do attend the service, here's what you will find :

- You will be expected to use hand sanitiser on entry to the building. This may cause a delay in entering, so please keep 2 metres from the people in front of you in the queue - a marshal will be there to ensure this happens.
- Seating will be 2 metres apart – household groups may sit together. Stewards will be around to help you find a suitable place to sit, and to monitor social distancing as you take your places.
- The service will be printed and will be single-use (to be destroyed after the service) on Sunday 6th September, after this they will be collected and isolated for 72 hours.
- There will be no singing.
- If you want to receive communion, please re-sanitise hands.
- Do not kneel but stand to receive communion, which will be dropped into your open hands by the celebrant (who will be wearing a mask). Communion is distributed in silence (no words of distribution is 'the body of Christ' and no response 'Amen').
- Communion will be of one kind only (bread, no wine)
- There will be no physical contact for blessing of non-communicants.
- There will be no refreshments after the service. If you want to chat, please remember social distancing, and, weather permitting, leave the building and chat outside.
